

This factsheet is a profile of business owners from Ethnic Communities¹. It builds on the Business Development domain in *Ethnic Evidence* 2024.






4 in 10 ethnic business owners are women



Auckland dominates as the main hub for ethnic business owners



20% of business owners in New Zealand are from **Ethnic Communities**





Ethnic business owners are highly educated – almost half hold a bachelor's degree or higher, and Middle Eastern and Continental European business owners stand out at postgraduate levels.



Most ethnic business owners are aged 30–64



Chinese (65%), Indian (57%) and Middle Eastern (61%) owners cluster in Auckland






Industry variation



Proportion of business owners by ethnicity and gender




Educational qualifications
