Response to your Official Information Act request

Thank you for your email of 4 March 2025 to the Department of Internal Affairs (the Department). Your request was partially transferred on 13 March 2025 to the Ministry for Ethnic Communities (the Ministry) requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

1. *How much money has the MEC paid to ethnic communities in Christchurch since March 2019 by year and by ethnic group? Please indicate whether it was paid as a loan or grant.*
2. *To which groups/organisations were the funds paid to?*
3. *What did they use the money for? (please provide financial accounting statements)*
4. *In particular, when discussing Q2 and Q3, please provide answers re:*
 - *Asturlab*
 - *Al Aqsa Mosque*
 - *the March 15 Whanau Trust*
 - *Sakina Trust*
 - *Muslim Association of Canterbury*
 - *Linwood Charitable Trust*
 - *individuals associated by membership or in roles, whether paid or unpaid, with any of the aforementioned organisations.*
5. *How much money has MEC or DIA asked to be returned, from whom, and how much is still outstanding?*
6. *How much debt or payments has MEC or the DIA forgiven or written off and in connection with which organisations and individuals?*
7. *Were any conflicts of interest identified by MEC or DIA between members of the Muslim or other communities and DIA/MEC staff/contractors. Specifically, have any conflicts been identified involving Habib Marwat and/or the Southern Communities Engagement Team? Please detail: who, what, when, etc. and add in what action was taken by DIA, MEC and/or the people involved.*
8. *Has any civil action been taken against any of the above parties in relation to matters in Qs 2, 4, 5 or 6? How many suits have been settled out of court and at what cost to the DIA and/or MEC?*
9. *How times has DIA/MEC referred matters in relation to Qs 2, 4, 5 or 6 to Police and/or the Serious Fraud Office or other auditing body? Please detail: who, what, when, etc.*
10. *How many audits have been done of any parties in relation to matters in Qs 2, 4, 5 or 6? Please detail: who, what, when, etc.*

11. Please provide any internal documents reporting concerns relating to any of the individuals and/or organisations that received DIA/MEC funding.

The Ministry will provide responses for questions one to five and question seven with data from March 2019 onwards. For questions six, eight, nine, ten and eleven, the Ministry will respond from the date of its establishment onwards (1 July 2021). The Department will respond with any information prior to 1 July 2021.

Question One

Please refer to the table below for all funds that have been paid to ethnic communities from 15 March 2019. Please note that the Ministry does not give loans and that all the data is from Christchurch organisations delivering in Christchurch/ Canterbury. Please also note that the information provided has been extracted as of 31 March 2025.

Question Two

Please see *Appendix A: Organisations funded in Christchurch by MEC* for a breakdown of the funding provided by the Ministry to all organisations in Christchurch since 15 March 2019. This has been separated into different financial years for your reference.

Questions Three and Four

On 26 March 2025, we clarified with you that this part of your request should only include expenditure reports for the organisations listed in question four of the request. However, as discussed, if you believe that any of the other organisations included in the data from questions one and two also require such documentation, you are welcome to submit a follow-up request, and we will endeavour to provide the additional documentation.

In response to your request, 12 documents have been found within scope and are summarised in the document schedule. They are being released to you in full.

The specific funding data for these organisations has also been added to a table for you to refer to in *Appendix B: Funding to Listed Organisations*.

Please note that we have not given any grants to individuals or to Al Aqsa Mosque. There are also three rounds of funding in the table in *Appendix B* that have not been included in the document list, these have not been delivered to us yet but are being followed up with by the ECDF team.

Question 5

Please refer to the refund column in *Appendix A: Organisations funded in Christchurch by MEC* for information on the amount of money that has been refunded to the Ministry.

In situations where recipients are not able to spend all their grants, especially smaller amounts, we usually encourage them to use it towards other community projects or events which are agreed on with the Ministry. If the unspent grant is a large amount and they do not have any events or projects to use the funds on, the excess amount is refunded to the Ministry.

Question Six

All funds were paid in the form of grants, and the Ministry has no record of any debts being written off since 1 July 2021. Recipients are required to use the grant for the purpose they provided on their application. After they complete their event/project, they are required to provide the Ministry a results report in narrative form and an expenditure report to provide accountability of how and where the grant was spent.

Question Seven:

The Ethnic Communities Development Fund (ECDF) is administered by the Ministry to support initiatives and promote social cohesion and the development of ethnic communities in New Zealand. The fund is managed with strict adherence to the Ministry's strategic priorities and funding criteria.

Regarding Habib Marwat, while they were employed by the Ministry, it is important to clarify that they were not involved in any work related to the ECDF team or the making of funding decisions. Consequently, they had no influence over the allocation of funds or assessment of applications.

The Ministry ensures that all funding decisions are made transparently and impartially with a panel of external advisors drawn from ethnic communities assisting in the assessment process to maintain objectivity and a community perspective. The process involves three stages.

1. Applications are sent to the Ministry's Community Advisors, who then make recommendations to the panel.
2. This is then followed with a monthly panel assessment.
3. Then the final decision sits with the DCE of Corporate Services.

To address conflict of interest concerns, the Ministry has robust policies in place. These policies require that any potential conflicts of interest are declared and managed appropriately. This includes ensuring that panel members with a conflict of interest are excluded from discussions and decisions relating to funding decisions. The Ministry's commitment to ethical practices and transparency helps to uphold the integrity of the ECDF and ensures that funding decisions are made solely based on the merits of the applications and their alignment with the Ministry's strategic priorities. Questions Eight to Ten

The Ministry has not taken any civil action, referred any matters relating to the ECDF fund to the Police or completed any audits for the organisations included in the response to questions one and two. Therefore, I am going to refuse this part of your request under section 18(e) as this information does not exist.

Please see *Appendix C: ECDF Complaints Register for Listed Organisations* which refers to two complaints within the scope of this request. I am refusing to provide any other internal information under section 18(f) as further internal documents and correspondence would require substantial collation.
